- 3:40 AM. Bengaluru Airport Half-asleep eyes. Quiet excitement this isn't going to be a regular weekend
- 10:40 AM. Langkawi a little sun, a little stillness & car keys passed around. We'll call shotgun, turn up the volume & head to brunch
- From there, the road curves inland music still going, windows down until the villa appears where rooms spill into each other. Conversations start without effort
- Later, we rise with the island express entry to SkyBridge, SkyCab, SkyRex & 3D Art Gallery
- By golden hour, we're at a beach café in Pantai Cenang Fireshows, Music & the first story
- Back at the villa, the pace shifts A track loops. A game starts. A story lands. The surface holds but something stirs underneath







Where it Sails



- Mornings stretch slow Someone's on the aux. Someone else is already belly-flopping in the pool We move at villa pace until we don't

Do I have to pay the Membership Access at once?

No — the payment will be in parts. We'll share all the details clearly with the invite.

Do Indian passport holders need a visa for Malaysia?

No. Indian citizens can enter Malaysia visa-free for up to 30 days until December 31, 2026. A short prearrival form MDAC (Malaysia Digital Arrival Card) is required — we'll assist you with it.

What's the daily cost for meals and other basics?

Approximately ₹1,500–₹2,500 per day.

Where can I exchange currency?

Currency exchange is available at Langkawi International Airport and a few reliable spots nearby. We'll be there to assist you.

How can I stay connected during the trip?

Local SIM cards (TuneTalk, Digi, Hotlink) are available at the airport. International roaming from Indian carriers also works well. We will provide all relevant details with the invite.

Is Wi-Fi available at the stay?

Yes — high-speed Wi-Fi is available at the Tribe Home throughout the stay.

Any local spots you'd recommend nearby?

Yes — we've handpicked some great cafés, clubs, and low-key gems. So you're covered.
